

TEQUESTA POST-STORM RESIDENT INFORMATION PLAN

In the event that a loss of power has created difficulty in residents obtaining information about the recovery activities in the Village, the Village of Tequesta has developed a system for disseminating post-storm information that residents need to assist them in their decision making. The type of information that we will attempt to provide will be determined by the needs of the residents but typically includes shelter openings and closings, power, phone and cable restoration progress, sewer and water information including any boil-water orders, trash and debris removal progress and locations for ice, water and food.

The methods that we will use are as follows:

- 1) Daily press releases will be provided to all local newspapers, radio and television stations.
- 2) The Jupiter Courier and Hometown News have agreed to provide space for Tequesta specific information.
- 3) WJTW Radio, located at 100.3 FM will provide Tequesta information at 20-minutes past the hour, every hour.
- 4) Hurricane information flyers will be placed in special newspaper boxes, labeled as such at:
 - a. Beach Road across from the entrance to Jupiter Inlet Colony
 - b. The corner of Beach Road and US Hwy. One
 - c. Directly in front of Publix on US Hwy. One
 - d. The NW corner of US Hwy. One and Tequesta Drive
 - e. Seabrook Road, in front of the Recreation Dept.
 - f. The NW corner of Tequesta Drive and Riverside Drive
 - g. At the south entrance of Tequesta Country Club
- 5) An information booth will be set up in the lobby of the Public Safety Building at 357 Tequesta Drive.

We hope that these efforts will keep our residents informed, and we appreciate any suggestions that you have to improve this system.
