- **DISASTER PREPAREDNESS**
 - Actions to take before, during, and after a disaster.
- **FIRE SUPPRESSION**
 - Fire chemistry, hazardous materials, and fire suppression strategies.
- **DISASTER MEDICAL OPERATIONS**
 - First aid training and practice.
- **SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATIONS**
 - Search and rescue planning and techniques.
- **DISASTER PSYCHOLOGY AND TEAM ORGANIZATION**
 - The signs and symptoms experienced by the disaster survivor and worker.
- **Terrorism**
 - Definition of Terrorism and terrorist goals.
