St. Lucie County evacuation zones

CATEGORY 1-3

■ All barrier islands

Fort Pierce:

■ Along Moores Creek east of Means Court, south of Avenue D, north of Avenue B and west of North Second Street

■ Along and south of Taylor Creek, east of North 13th Street, west of U.S. 1 and north of Avenue M

■ Along and east of Old Dixie Highway from the North Beach Causeway south to U.S. 1

■ Along and east of North Second Street from Taylor Creek south to Citrus Avenue

Port St. Lucie:

■ All residents east and north of Southbend Boulevard

■ West and south of Westmoreland Boulevard from Port St. Lucie Boulevard to Martin County

■ West of Midport Road from Lyngate Park to U.S. 1

■ Vikings Landing

Unincorporated areas:

■ Along and east of Old Dixie Highway from the Indian River County line to North Beach Causeway

■ Along the North Fork of the St. Lucie River south of Bell Avenue, west of Sunrise Boulevard and north of Midway Road; along French Creek west of Oleander Boulevard; and south of Midway Road and west of Citrus Avenue, including River Hammock and Canoe Creek

■ Along and west of South Indian River Drive from Eden Plantation south to Martin County; Bay St. Lucie and Beau Rivage

CATEGORY 4-5

All areas from above categories

Fort Pierce:

■ North of Orange Avenue in an area starting at Orange Avenue and North 13th Street to Avenue E, east to North Second Street, south to Orange Avenue and west to North 13th Street

■ South of Orange Avenue in an area starting at Orange Avenue and South 10th Street to Delaware Avenue, east to South Sixth Street, north to Orange Avenue

Port St. Lucie:

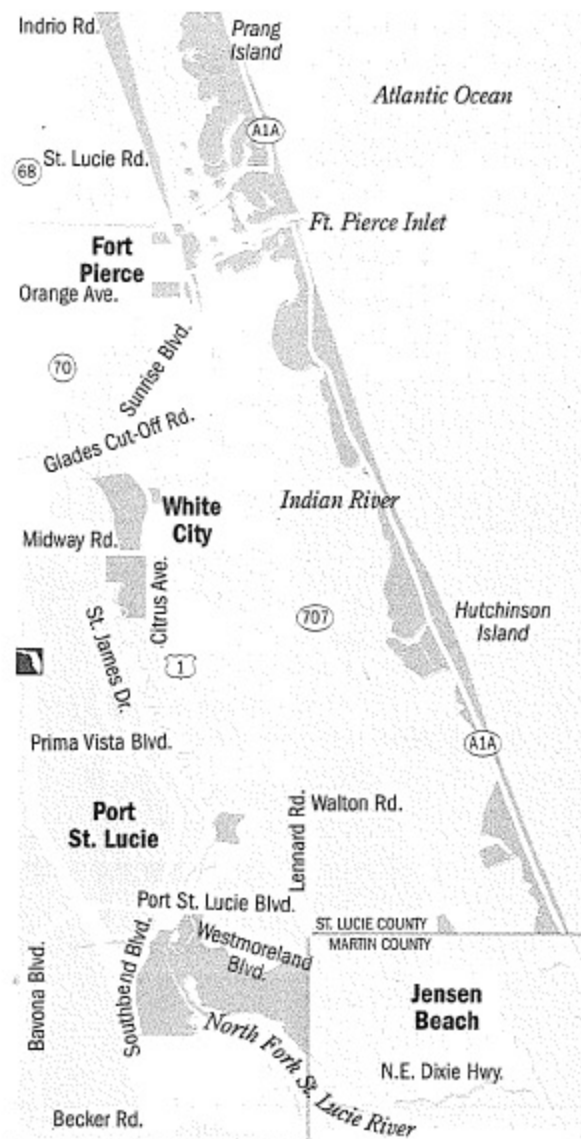
■ Residents south of C-24 canal, east of Turnpike, and north of Becker Road

■ West of Midport Road from Port St. Lucie Boulevard to U.S. 1

■ West bank of North Fork of the St. Lucie River

Unincorporated areas:

■ Harbour Ridge and Wide Waters



Martin County evacuation zones

CATEGORY 1

■ All barrier islands

■ All low-lying areas — those that flood in heavy rains and are less than 10 feet above sea level — within half a mile of the Indian River, the St. Lucie River or the Loxahatchee River

area west of Kanner Highway, Port Salerno, Hobe Sound east of SR A1A, south county east of U.S. 1 and most areas of Turtle Creek, Little Club, Rivers Edge, Jupiter River Estates, Wood Haven, River Bend and Heritage Oaks

CATEGORY 2-3

■ All areas from above category

■ Low-lying areas within three-fourths of a mile of waterways — including most of North River Shores, Palm City east of Mapp Road, the Stuart and Tropical Farms

CATEGORY 4-5

■ All areas from above categories

■ Low-lying areas within 1 mile of waterways, including Rio, Jensen Beach, Stuart, Palm City, Tropical Farms, Port Salerno and Hobe Sound
